

Eco-Chic Frames

There's no need to spend a fortune on photo frames. You can make eco-chic ones at home. Capture those special moments with cute juice carton frames! Juicy **couture**, indeed.

Here's what you need:

- scissors
- 1-quart cardboard juice carton, clean and dry
- pencil
- ruler
- hole punch
- 2 straws
- glue
- 3- by 5-inch photo

Step 1

Cut one panel from an empty juice carton. Draw a rectangle measuring 2½ inches tall and 4½ inches wide in the middle of the panel. Carefully cut out the square.

Step 2

Make three evenly spaced accordion-style folds on the right side of the opening. With the side still folded, use a hole punch to make indents where holes need to be punched for the straws.

Step 3

Unfold the side and punch holes where the indents are.

Step 4 (not pictured)

Repeat steps 2 and 3 on the left side. Make sure the holes on the left are even with the holes on the right.

Step 5

Slide a straw through the holes at the top of the frame. Trim the straw if it sticks out too much on one side. Repeat on bottom.

Step 6

Apply a thin layer of glue around the edges on the front side of a photo. Glue the photo to the backside of the frame so the picture shows through the opening.
