
# Pocket Books


Between school, family, and friends, it can be tough to keep track of your to-do list. You can keep everything in one easy place with this pocket-sized notepad. Because it's made of junk mail, you can make as many as you need.

# Here's what you need:

- ruler
- scissors
- thin cardboard
- junk mail letters, one-sided
- junk mail envelopes







## Step 1

Measure and cut out a 1½ inch by 2½ inch piece of thin cardboard.

#### Step 2

Using junk mail letters and envelopes, measure and cut out 15 pieces of paper that are 4 inches long by  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches wide.

## Step 3

Fold the cardboard in half so it is ¾ inch wide by 2½ inches long.

# Step 4

Place the junk mail pieces inside the fold with the blank sides facing up. Make sure the sides of the paper stack are even.

#### Step 5

Bind the notepad together by stapling twice across the top.

#### Step 6

Use markers to decorate the top of your new notepad.

Why stop at just junk letters? Rock out the recycling and use old school papers with printing on only one side. Just make sure your parents see your papers first!
