

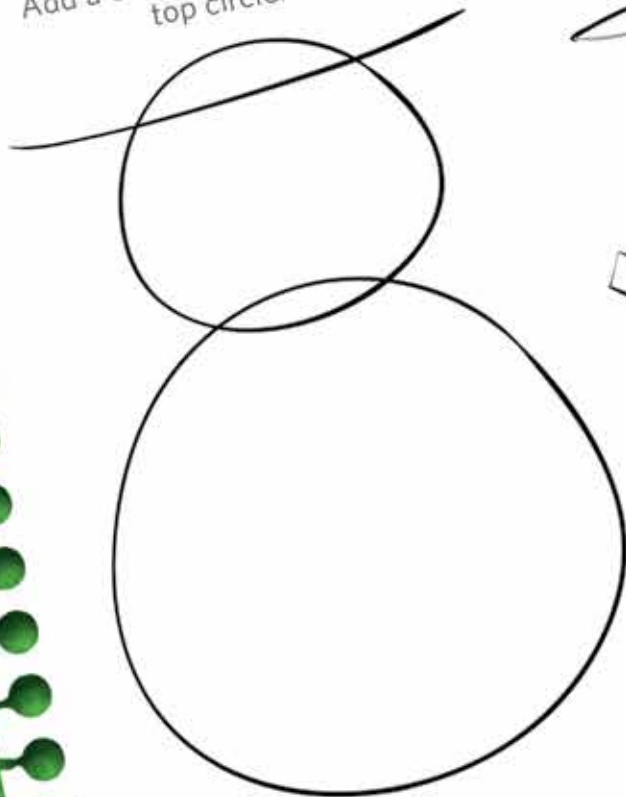
# A Christmas DRAWING Wonderland!

## No-Melt Man

**START HERE:** It doesn't matter what the temperature is outside. Draw this snowman to have a friend that will never melt away.

### STEP 1

Draw a large circle. Then draw a smaller circle overlapping the first. Add a curved line across the top circle.



### STEP 2

Turn the top curve line into an oval. Add a carrot nose and the start of two arms. Use curved lines to start a scarf too.



### STEP 3

Use curved lines to draw the top of the hat. Add rounded stick fingers to the arms. Then use curved lines to complete the scarf.



### STEP 4

Add detail lines to the hat, arms, and nose. Give the snowman eyes and a mouth. Draw two buttons on his belly. Finish by adding detail to the scarf.



What's more fun than celebrating Christmas? Try drawing Christmas! Become an artist, and learn to sketch the sights and symbols that make this holiday special. It just takes a pencil . . . and a bit of Christmas cheer!

### MATERIALS

Every artist needs a well-stocked toolbox. Take a minute before you begin drawing to gather what you need:

- Blank, unlined paper
- Plenty of sharp pencils
- A good pencil sharpener
- A good pencil eraser
- Ink pen or felt-tip marker

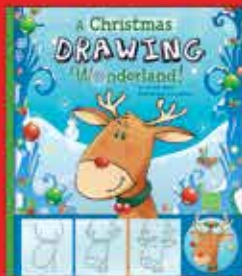

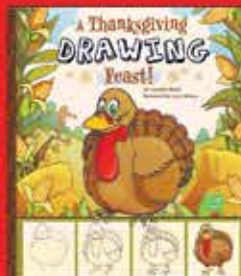

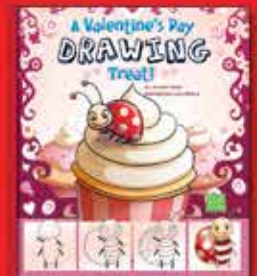
